Dress for this game will be the black polo (to be issued this week) and school approved khaki shorts with a belt. It is important that student have a flip folder and lyre for their instrument. While we are memorizing music for the field, music in the stands must be read. Please get this ASAP.

Please make sure you have the medical release form turned into us before the game- Your band student will not be able to attend if they do not have this form notarized and turned in.

Objective sheets will also be passed out this week. Please make sure that you see and sign these sheets. These objectives are the outline of what will be expected of every student in his/her band class during the 6 weeks period. These objectives are 30% of your child's band grade. These objectives can be used to determine chair placement or any other status in any band class. Please make sure that you ask to see these sheets once a week, every six weeks. If you are wondering how your child is doing in class, you will know very quickly by looking at their objective sheet.

I want to strongly encourage private lessons for your student(s). The weekly 30-minute one-on-one instruction that your child receives in these lessons is invaluable to them as an instrumentalist. I cannot stress to you enough the amount of success that these lessons will bring to your child, as well as the success they will experience in the band program. The Mesquite ISD lesson rate is \$18.00 per 30 minutes of instruction.

Water and tissue- If you have not yet sent your case of water, please send them as soon as possible. You may place them in the pile outside the office in front of the window.
